NOTIFICATION

As per the approval accorded vide Government Order No. IDD 90 DIA 2016, dated:18.04.2017, Government of Karnataka is pleased to notify the following Airports (hereinafter called "RCS Airports") within the State under the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) – UDAN of the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India:

2. In terms of the MoU dated 20.04.2017 signed between Government of Karnataka and Government of India and AAI (Implementing Agency), Government of Karnataka notify that the following concessions shall be extended to the selected Airline operators for operating flights at the above mentioned RCS Airports within the State:-
- a. State Government shall reduce Sales Tax (ST) to 1% or less on ATF at RCS Airports and for RCS flights from other airports located within the state for a period of 10 years.
 - b. State Government shall provide minimum land, if required, and wherever available free of cost and free from all encumbrances for development and expansion of RCS Airports after due consideration based on extant policy of State on case to case basis. The State Government will coordinate with Government of India to provide rail and metro connectivity to the RCS airports;
 - c. State Government shall provide security and fire services free of cost at Government RCS Airports, for private RCS Airports, it will be examined on case to case basis.
 - d. State government shall provide or cause to be provided, electricity, water and other utility services at concessional rates only at RCS Government Airports; and

- e. State Government shall provide 20% share of VGF determined pursuant to this scheme. The State Government shall need to reimburse its VGF share within 3 months of being asked by the Central Government. In case the State Government does not reimburse, a notice will be sent by the Central Government requiring reimbursement within 1 month of the notice, failing which, the Central Government / Implementing Agency will not consider any further RCS proposals under the Scheme for connecting airports from the State.
- f. State Government will examine any additional incentives over and above the incentives being provided under the Scheme by Central Government and State Government, if any policy of the State Government allows to do so.
- g. The State Government shall need to continue the concessions as mandated in the NCAP, 2016 and the Scheme document. In case the State Government stops providing the concessions during the tenure of the Scheme, they will be required to resume the concessions immediately. In case the concessions are not resumed within 1 month from the date of discontinuation, the Central Government / Implementing Agency will not consider any further RCS proposals under the Scheme for connecting airports from the State.

Government of Karnataka is liable to resume concessions only, in the event of no default from the other two parties to the agreement.

Any dispute arises between the parties in the execution of contract that they would enter in to, in pursuance of MoU, that such dispute shall be resolved in the following manner:-

- a) Firstly, by mutual discussions.
- b) Secondly, if not settled by mutual discussion by invoking the provision of Arbitration and Conciliation Act.
